## Mathematics Course Sequence Grade 5-8

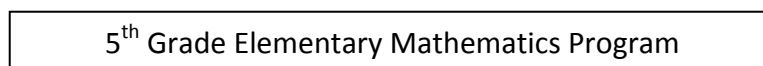
### 2011-2012 School Year

**Course Sequence Flow Chart**

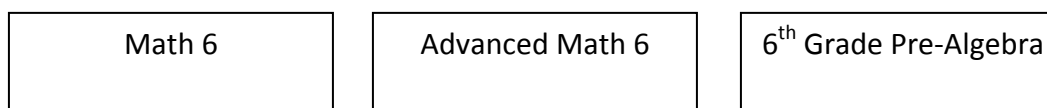
**Elementary School**

Grade 5



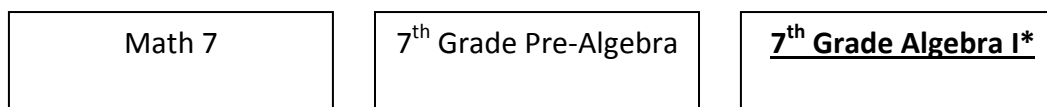
**Sixth Grade Buildings**

Grade 6

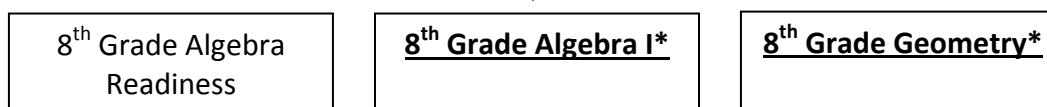


**Middle School**

**Starting in grade 6, students are placed into the respective math courses by utilizing the following data information:**

**Used of 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Math Placement:**

- 4<sup>th</sup> Grade OAA math score
- 5<sup>th</sup> grade Winter MAP Math RIT
- 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Hilliard Math Placement Test

**Used of 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Math Placement:**

- 5<sup>th</sup> Grade OAA math score
- 6<sup>th</sup> grade Winter MAP Math RIT
- 7<sup>th</sup> grade Hilliard Math Placement Test

**Used of 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Math Placement:**

Student's assessment scores, grades, and work ethic determine their placement into 8<sup>th</sup> grade math courses.

**\*This is a high school credited class. Your child's final grade will be posted on his/her high school transcript.**

*A parent can request a meeting with the school principal to discuss his/her child's placement. The principal will determine who attends the meeting.*
